Chapel (K-5)

The end of the passage in verse 14 says, "For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted." Just like Jesus Christ, we are to have an attitude of humility.

Chapel (6-12)

Mr. Kolar talked to the students about God's will for our life: Sanctification. I Thessalonians 4:3a states, "It is God's will that you should be sanctified." If God is holy, we are to be holy. Just like sympathetic resonance in Physics, we should resonate what we hear from God.
