1. We believe the Bible, in the original writings, is the inerrant word of God given for reproof, correction, and training in righteousness. II Timothy 3:16
We believe in one God, eternally existent in three Persons; God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. **Genesis 1:26, Deuteronomy 6:4, Matthew 28:19, John 15:26**

2. 4. We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit by which men are regenerated and granted life and grace to live godly and holy lives in the present evil world. **Titus 3:5, Galatians 5:22-23**

5. We believe that Satan exists today as the enemy of God and the accuser of God's people. He persistently seeks to counterfeit the works and truth of God. **Isaiah 14:12-14, Ezekiel 28:12-17, Acts 26:18, Ephesians 6:10-13, Revelation 12:1-17, Revelation 19:17-21**

6. We believe in the personal return of the Lord Jesus Christ. We believe in the bodily resurrection of all the dead; the saved to eternal life, dwelling, forever with Christ; the unsaved to everlasting judgment and condemnation. **Matthew 24:29-30, Acts 1:11, Revelation 20:1-6**

STATEMENT ON MARRIAGE, GENDER, AND SEXUALITY

1. We believe that every person must be afforded compassion, love, kindness, respect, and dignity. Hateful and harassing behavior or attitudes directed toward any individual are to be repudiated and are not in accord with Scripture nor the doctrines of Evangelical Bible Church, and its ministry Hope Christian Academy. **Mark 12:28-31; Luke 6:31**

2. We believe that God wonderfully and immutably creates each person according to His design and sovereign will. The two distinct, complementary genders of male and female reflect the image and nature of God. Rejection of one's biological sex is a rejection of the image of God within that person. **Genesis 1:26-27, Matthew 19:4**

3. We believe that the term "marriage" has only one meaning: the uniting of one biological man and one biological woman in a single, exclusive, lifelong union, as delineated in Scripture. We believe that God intends sexual intimacy to occur only between a man and a woman who are married to each other. We believe that God has commanded that no intimate sexual activity be engaged in outside of a marriage between a man and a woman. **Genesis 2:18-25, 1 Corinthians 6:18; 7:2-5; Hebrews 14:4**

4. We believe that any form of sexual immorality (including adultery, fornication, homosexual behavior, bisexual conduct, bestiality, incest, polygamy, transgenderism, pedophilia, and use of pornography) is sinful and offensive to God. **Matthew 15:18-20; 1 Corinthians 6:9-10**

5. We believe that in order to preserve the function and integrity of Evangelical Bible Church as the local Body of Christ, and to provide a biblical role model to HCA and the community, it is imperative that all persons employed by HCA in any capacity, or who serve as volunteers, agree to and abide by this Statement on Marriage, Gender, and Sexuality. **Matthew 5:16; Philippians 2:14-16; 1 Thessalonians 5:22**

6. We believe that God offers redemption and restoration to all who confess and forsake their sin, seeking His mercy and forgiveness through Jesus Christ. **Acts 3:19-21; Romans 10:9-10; 1 Corinthians 6:9-11**

HOPE CHRISTIAN ACADEMY STUDENT LIFESTYLE STATEMENT
