Chapel (K-6)

Today during chapel Mr. Bradley talked to the students about the importance of being disciplined. The Bible tells us that God shows His love for us by disciplining us. When our parents, teachers, and others discipline us, it might not be pleasant at the time but it is for our good. We are disciplined to learn obedience. It also shows we are true sons and daughters of Him. The following scripture was shared during chapel:

Hebrews 12:7-11

"It is for discipline that you have to endure. God is treating you as sons. For what son is there whom his father does not discipline? 8 If you are left without discipline, in which all have participated, then you are illegitimate children and not sons. 9 Besides this, we have had earthly fathers who disciplined us and we respected them. Shall we not much more be subject to the Father of spirits and live? 10 For they disciplined us for a short time as it seemed best to them, but he disciplines us for our good, that we may share his holiness. 11 For the moment all discipline seems painful rather than pleasant, but later it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it."

This morning Pastor Tim began a three week chapel series on finances. He informed the students that the Bible has a lot to say about money. They focused on the word "steward" this morning. A "steward" is someone who manages what belongs to someone else.

The students looked at the Parable of the Talents in Matthew 25 with an exhortation to not waste our lives on this earth, but to bear fruit for the kingdom. They also talked about Christians being stewards of their time, their minds and bodies, and their wealth. Deuteronomy 8:18 reminds us that it is God who has given them the ability to get wealth.
