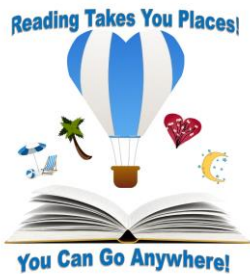
We are proud of our students for representing Christ and HCA well. Great job Hadassah, Sadie, Dru, & Julianne!
