Congrats to Our HCA Geographic Bee Winner

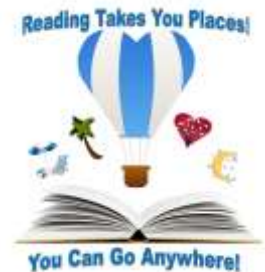
