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## Chapel (K-6)

Today, we covered episode three of "Missionary to Slocum Alley." Ask your student to tell you how the story unfolded. We reviewed Matthew 9:35-36, focusing on the many who need to be reached and the different reactions we may encounter as we share the gospel. As a missionary, our responsibility is to be available and willing to sow seeds of the Gospel. It is God who makes it grow – 1 Corinthians 3:5-6. We talked about what God's Word says when we sow His Word – Isaiah 55:11. Even though Charlie's initial attempt at witnessing didn't work with Red, he felt at peace because he took a bold first step in witnessing. We must not let Satan discouraged us when someone doesn't respond to our attempts at witnessing.

## JH/HS Chapel (7-12)

Mr. Warm concluded his study on Philippians 4:8 by looking at the words lovely, good report, virtue, and praiseworthy. He then moved into Philippians 4:9 and talked about how Christ uses our testimony. They looked at the idea of how we move from merely understanding and deliberating these things to actually allowing these things to affect the way we live our lives, and the importance of actually being doers of the Word and not hearers only.
