Chapel (K-6)

During chapel today, Mr. Bradley talked to the students about the sequence of events that led up to the day of Pentecost. Pentecost simply means "fifty." Israel counted seven weeks or seven Sabbaths from the first fruits offering of barley. The day after the seven Sabbath would be day 50.

This day had significance for several reasons. First it was the beginning of the wheat harvest, and we know that on the day of Pentecost 3,000 people were saved. Second, we know that the gift of the Holy Spirit was given. Jesus ascended into heaven to prepare a place for His bride, but He gave us the Spirit as a gift, a pledge, a promise of His return. One day He will come back and receive us, and we will be with Him forever.

JH/HS Chapel (7-12)

Today in chapel, Mr. Eliason spoke to the students about surrender over control. He used the scripture Proverbs 3:5-6 and discussed how we need to give control over to God in many areas of our lives. He shared about the consequences of Abram and Sarai when they took control of the situation instead of letting God control whether they would have a child. There are and were consequences which have stemmed even to today because of their sin. He concluded by asking questions that we need to ask ourselves when it we choose to surrender control:

1. Is it worth my concern?
2. Is it mine to control?
3. Is it for God alone?
