Chapel (K-6)

Today during chapel, Mr. Bradley continued talking to the students about the Lord's Prayer. He spoke about what a privilege it is to be called children of God and how our Father is shaping us and molding us into the image of His Son. Scripture referenced today was Isaiah 64:8 and I John 3:1.

Chapel (7-12)

Today in chapel, Pastor Tim continued speaking to the students about prayer. They began chapel with Psalm 8:3-4 with the psalmist asking how it is even possible that the God of all creation is even mindful of man. He talked about how under the old covenant, the holiness of God kept people at a distance (Ex: Mt Sinai; tabernacle protocol of who could approach God). But under the new covenant, we have been brought near by the blood of Jesus Christ– Heb. 9.

They looked at Matthew 27:45-54 and how God made a way, through Jesus Christ, to have direct access to Him. What a privilege we now have in approaching God. "For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus." (1 Tim. 2:5) "Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need." (Heb. 4:16). Pastor Tim wanted our students to know what a privilege we have as God's children to be able to approach God. May we do it with a humble and contrite heart!

Library Rules

- ❖ All books/magazines are due back in two weeks. A due date is listed in each book/magazine (usually inside back cover).
- ❖ Four books and 2 magazines/videos may be checked out at a time.
- ❖ No more than 8 books and 4 magazines /videos may be out at any one time.
- ❖ If a student has more than four overdue books, they will not be allowed to check out any books until the overdue books are returned.
- ❖ Books may be returned at any time. Just drop them in the yellow crate outside the library door.
- ❖ A fine of five cents per school day per book/magazine/video, will be charged for overdue books/magazines/videos. (25 cents per week)
- ❖ A damage fee will be assessed for any books returned soiled or damaged.
- ❖ An overdue book list will be posted on the library door every Wednesday afternoon. Notices will be sent out each week if the overdue book is not returned, or the fine is not paid.
- ❖ Book fines may be given to the librarian on Wednesday or dropped off in the office in an envelope with the student's name on it. Please DO NOT leave money on the library table as this room is used by many people throughout the week.
