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## Elementary Chapel (K-6)

## Secondary Chapel (7-12)

For chapel today, Mr. Eliason and the students took a look at Psalm 28 and talked about prayer. Psalm 28 had four key points:

- 1). The Psalmist earnestly calls on God to hear his prayer (1-3).
- 2). He prays that he might not be counted among those who go astray after their own ways (3-5).
- 3). He rejoices because he knows that Yahweh has heard him and will be his strength (28.6-7)
- 4). He finally rejoices because he knows that Yahweh will also be the protector of all His people (28.8-9).

They then ended with the idea that in our lives and in our prayer time, we need to take the advice of Proverbs 3:5-6. This verse states, "trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding, but in all your ways acknowledge Him and He will direct your paths"
