Complete the packet for **each** student in your family. The family registration fee of \$250 is due once you submit the re-enrollment packet for the first student. Please be aware that class sizes fill quickly, and students who are not pre-registered will not be

guaranteed a spot for the next school year. Please contact the HCA office if you have questions.

Tuition Assistance

We do have various opportunities for families who require financial assistance:

- There are opportunities to serve within the school to pay down your tuition. See Mr. Bradley if you are interested.
- If you are unable to do the first option, then you may apply for financial aid. Those applications need to be submitted online by April 15.
- If you still have financial needs after the first two options, you may appeal to the board for special consideration.
