Re-Enrollment / Pre-Registration: Now Open!

Re-enrollment for the 2024-2025 school year is now open. All families currently enrolled can go to the FACTS family portal → click on Apply/Enroll → then click on Enrollment/Reenrollment. Complete the packet for **each** student in your family. The family registration fee of \$250 is due once you submit the re-enrollment packet for the first student. Please be aware that class sizes fill quickly, and students who are not pre-registered will not be

guaranteed a spot for the next school year. Please contact the HCA office if you have questions.

Tuition Assistance

We do have various opportunities for families who require financial assistance:

- There are opportunities to serve within the school to pay down your tuition. See Mr. Bradley if you are interested.
- If you are unable to do the first option, then you may apply for financial aid. Those applications need to be submitted online by April 15.

If you still have financial needs after the first two options, you may appeal to the board for special consideration.

Every family desiring financial aid for the next school year must complete the application online at https://hcadickinson.org/tuition-assistanceopportunities/ by April 15. Tax documents are required to complete the financial aid.
